ਆਸਨੁ ਪਵਨ ਦੂਰਿ ਕਰਿ ਬਵਰੇ ॥

Abandon your Yogic postures and breath control exercises, O madman.

ਛੋਡਿ ਕਪਟੁ ਨਿਤ ਹਰਿ ਭਜੁ ਬਵਰੇ ॥੧॥ ਰਹਾਉ ॥

Renounce fraud and deception, and meditate continuously on the Lord, O madman. ||1||Pause||
